Sac County Health Services is announcing upcoming H1N1 clinics to be held in Sac County:

Persons eligible for vaccination at this clinic include pregnant women, caregivers and household contacts of children less than 6 months of age, anyone 6 months through 24 years of age, children under 10 years of age that received their first dose of H1N1 vaccine and need 2nd dose and adults age 25 through 64 with a chronic medical condition. This is a walk in clinic with no appointment necessary. There is no charge for the H1N1 influenza vaccination.

Thursday, December 3 from 3:00 – 5:30 at the Sac County Health Services office in Sac City. (for children who need 2nd dose, must have received first dose on or before November 5th)

Wednesday, December 9 from 3:30 – 5:30 at East Sac County High School in Lake View. (for children who need 2nd dose, must have received first dose on or before November 11th)

Monday, December 14 from 4:00 – 6:30 at the Schaller Crestland school in Schaller (for children who need 2nd dose, must have received first dose on or before November 16th)
